<b>TITLE</b>	<b>recycling of school writing materials and paper</b>
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Action carried out by environmental delegates : recycling of school writing materials and paper for the benefit of an association which helps families who have experienced perinatal bereavement: installation of boxes in all classes, and collection of boxes regularly.
<b>PROCEDURE</b> <b>Steps to follow</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Discussion / meeting with the group at the start of the year: what do we want to do to combine ecology and solidarity?</li><li>- Search for partner associations.</li><li>- Contact with the association and meeting to explain their actions</li><li>- Group discussion, debates to choose the action: identification of the waste of pencils that are thrown in the trash, and paper that is not recycled.</li><li>- Work on communication with other students and staff: posters to collect boxes, then display in the school and on the boxes.</li><li>- Installation of boxes in the rooms</li><li>- Information for class delegates</li><li>- Collection of boxes and materials to recycle (paper, pencils, pens, etc.)</li><li>- Transmission to the association.</li></ul>
<b>MATERIAL</b>	Telephone and emails for contact with the association. Computer and poster printer.
<b>TIME</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- At the start of the project: 4 hours for the choice and construction of communication elements.</li><li>- 1 hour for explanation to class delegates</li><li>- Then: regular collection from classes, once a week for paper.</li></ul>
<b>GROUP SIZE</b>	20 students
<b>COMPETENCES AND SKILLS TO BE ACQUIRED</b>	Sense of listening and argumentation to debate. Kindness. Organization and autonomy for collection and links with the association. Communication for the creation of posters and information meetings.
<b>NOTES</b>	plan a precise schedule from the start so that students can organize their pick-ups. Provide regular reminders in classes (by contacting teachers, for example).
<b>School subjects involved</b>	Interdisciplinary: Moral and civic education (solidarity), French and media education (communication)
