TITLE	recycling of school writing materials and paper
DESCRIPTION	Action carried out by environmental delegates: recycling of school writing materials and paper for the benefit of an association which helps families who have experienced perinatal bereavement: installation of boxes in all classes, and collection of boxes regularly.
PROCEDURE Steps to follow	 Discussion / meeting with the group at the start of the year: what do we want to do to combine ecology and solidarity? Search for partner associations. Contact with the association and meeting to explain their actions Group discussion, debates to choose the action: identification of the waste of pencils that are thrown in the trash, and paper that is not recycled. Work on communication with other students and staff: posters to collect boxes, then display in the school and on the boxes. Installation of boxes in the rooms Information for class delegates Collection of boxes and materials to recycle (paper, pencils, pens, etc.) Transmission to the association.
MATERIAL	Telephone and emails for contact with the association. Computer and poster printer.
TIME	 At the start of the project: 4 hours for the choice and construction of communication elements. 1 hour for explanation to class delegates Then: regular collection from classes, once a week for paper.
GROUP SIZE	20 students
COMPETENCES AND SKILLS TO BE ADCQUIRED	Sense of listening and argumentation to debate. Kindness. Organization and autonomy for collection and links with the association. Communication for the creation of posters and information meetings.
NOTES	plan a precise schedule from the start so that students can organize their pick-ups. Provide regular reminders in classes (by contacting teachers, for example).
School subjects involved	Interdisciplinary: Moral and civic education (solidarity), French and media education (communication)
